We will meet at 25 Pedernales and depart at 7:58 PM.


We have a designated ride leader, volunteers helping us navigate intersections, and a pre-tested 8-mile route. Our route is optimized for bicycles, electric unicycles, skates, onewheels, skateboards, and other electronic devices.

Our after party includes over 100 pairs of free to borrow skates from Sharky Skate Rental Co. and music by Donavin Velez, founder of The Underground Atx.

There will also be free raffle prizes for attendees. Bring your snacks and a camp chair or blankets to hang out on the lawn or take breaks between dancing or skating.
